WORKING WITH THE LOCAL CHURCH

Knowing the importance of long-term perspective, ServLife works to enable and partner with local churches to impact the community where they exist. In many regions worldwide, the church is either marginalized or a rare exception in her community. Resources are often depleted or lacking, and indigenous leaders can feel they have little with which to impact their communities. Therefore, we seek to empower the community within working with the local church.



SERVLIFE'S INITIATIVES

Rescue and Care for At-Risk Children - Through our children's homes, outreach, and sponsorship, we help care for children who are risk of hunger, child labor, and being trafficked.

End Hunger - Through the ServLife Hope Fund we help provide poor families with small capital and training to start businesses.

Train and Multiply the Church - Through our training schools, we help equip and train local Christian workers and pastors to minister to their own people.

When individuals are transformed, so is the community where they live. Transformation is core to the gospel; Jesus Christ demonstrated a passion for justice in the communities He touched.
